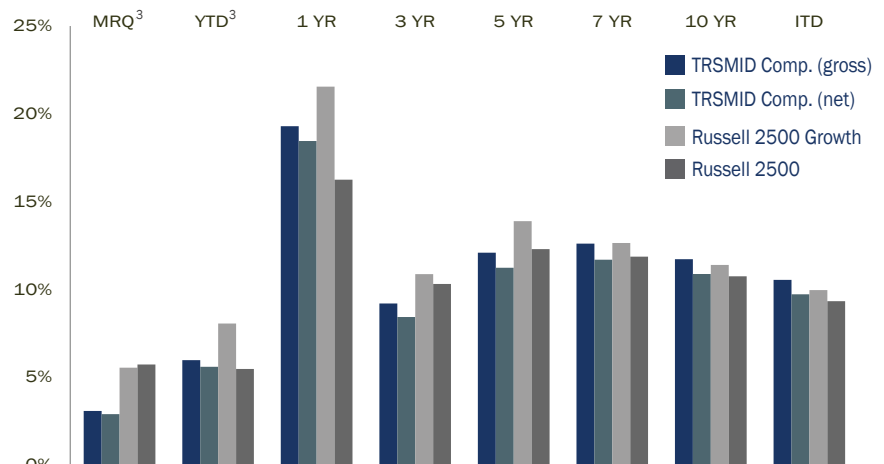

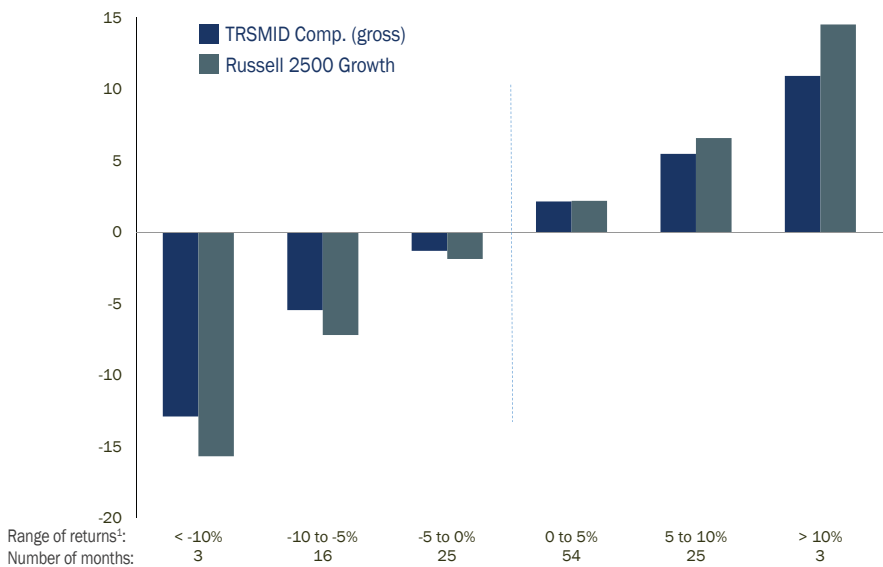

For comparison purposes, the Composite is measured against the Russell 2500 Growth and the Russell 2500 indices. The Russell 2500 Index is the Composite's secondary benchmark. The Russell 2500™ Index measures the performance of the small to mid-cap segment of the U.S. equity universe, commonly referred to as "smid" cap. The Russell 2500 Index is a subset of the Russell 3000® Index. It includes approximately 2500 of the smallest securities based on a combination of their market cap and current index membership. The Russell 2500™ Growth Index measures the performance of the small to mid-cap growth segment of the U.S. equity universe. It includes those Russell 2500 companies with higher growth earning potential as defined by Russell's leading style methodology. You cannot invest directly in an index.

The U.S. Dollar is the currency used to express performance. Returns are presented gross of management fees and include the reinvestment of all income. Actual returns will be reduced by investment advisory fees and other expenses that will be incurred in the management of the account. Torray's investment advisory fees are described in Part II of its Form ADV. The collection of fees produces a compounding effect on the total rate of return net of management fees. As an example, the effect of investment management fees on the total value of a client's portfolio assuming (a) quarterly fee assessment, (b) \$1,000,000 investment, (c) portfolio return of 8% a year, and (d) 1.00% annual investment advisory fee would be \$10,416 in the first year, and cumulative effects of \$59,816 over five years and \$143,430 over ten years. The annual composite dispersion presented is an asset-weighted standard deviation calculated for the accounts in the composite the entire year.

The management fee schedule is as follows: 1.00% on assets up to \$5 million, 0.75% on next \$20 million, 0.50% on next \$175 million; 0.375% on next \$100 million, and 0.25% on balance. Actual investment advisory fees incurred by clients may vary. A representative example (in the form of a table, chart, graph, or narrative) which shows the effect that an investment advisory fee, compounded over a period of years, could have on the total value of a client's portfolio.
